



## UPDATE ON REOPENING LIBRARY SERVICES

**LAGRANGE, GA - 10 JUNE 2020** - Hello Troup-Harris Library Patrons: Next week our libraries will be expanding the availability of our services. Here are our immediate plans. As always, thank you so very much for your patience, as we gradually reopen our services to the public.

### LaGrange Memorial Library



On 6/15, the library will be open to the public on a metered basis for browsing collections, checking out materials, account registration and updating, and computer services. Their meeting room will have six computer workstations available for use. Staff will be limiting the number of patrons engaged in non-computer activity to 10 at any given time, and will ask patrons to limit their time spent in the library to 30 minutes. Those entering the library will be no-contact temperature screened, and required to use hand sanitizer and a mask.

Future plans include opening up for children's story time in July, with standard protective protocols in place. Curbside pick up, for those who desire this manner of materials delivery, will continue through the month of June.

### Hogansville Public Library



The library in Hogansville will be opening up their meeting room with limited computer use on 6/15. They will be extending hours for curbside service to MTWRF 10-4, and Sat 10-2. On June 22nd, the library will open to the public with these same limited hours. As in LaGrange, those entering the library will be no-contact temperature screened, and required to use hand sanitizer and a mask.

## Harris County Public Library



Effective 6/15, the Harris library will expand their curbside services to MTWRF 10-4, and their book drop will now be open seven days a week.
